Preamble

The essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and good citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

I therefore agree:

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or sporting event.
6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
10. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also deemphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
14. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
15. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
16. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

LITTLE LEAGUE WAIVER:

1. I/We, the parents/guardians of the above-named candidate for a position on a Little League team, hereby give my/our approval to participate in any and all Little League activities, including transportation to and from the activities.
2. I/We know that participation in baseball or softball may result in serious injuries and protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players, and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the local Little League, Little League Baseball, Incorporated, the organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting my/our child to and from activities from any claim arising out of any injury to my/our child whether the result of negligence or for any other cause.
3. I/We agree to return upon request the uniform and other equipment issued to my/our child in as good conditions as when received except normal wear and tear.

SPALL TRYOUTS:

For New players to the League or players that were on a Minor team in 2009 and are League Age 9 to 12 may attend try-outs for Major Baseball or Major Softball. MAJOR BASEBALL AND MAJOR SOFTBALL RE-DRAFT:

Starting in the 2008 Season, SPALL instituted an annual re-draft whereby all Major teams place returning players back into the pool for re-draft each year. The concept of the re-draft each season is to create more balanced teams and more competitive play from one season to the next. Note that players previously on a Major team must be selected to a Major team and may not be moved to the Minor League.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE and PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

1. FOR TEE-BALL AND NEW PLAYERS TO SPALL:

I/We will show the above named candidate's proof of legal residence and an original or state certified copy of his/her birth certificate during the Walk-in Registration scheduled on JAN 30th, 1pm-3pm at the SP Community Center.

2. FOR RETURNING PLAYERS TO SPALL:

Upon request of League Officials, I/We will show the above named candidate's proof of legal residence and an original or state certified copy of his/her birth certificate.

3. FOR ALL:

I/We understand that our child (candidate) must be eligible under the residence and age regulations of Little League Baseball, Incorporated, to participate in this local league, and that if any controversy arises regarding residence and/or age, the decision of the Charter Committee in Williamsport shall be final and binding. I/We further understand that if any participant on a Little League Team does not qualify for participation in the league based on residence (as defined by Little League Baseball, Incorporated) and/or age, such participant and/or team on which he/she participates be found ineligible, and forfeit(s) and/or suspension of Tournament privileges may be decreed by action of the Charter Committee or Tournament Committee.

RAFFLE:

South Portland American Little League will be holding its annual raffle ticket fundraiser. Once again, a portion of the funds will be used as prizes (i.e. \$1000, \$500, and \$250) while the remainder will be used for capital improvements and to purchase uniforms, insurance and equipment. This year, in order to secure the necessary funding, each family will be responsible for buying a minimum of six tickets (i.e. \$5 each for a total of \$30). A family has the option to write their name on the ticket(s) and enter the drawing or they may choose to resell the tickets, in order to recoup their \$30, and allow the new buyer to enter the drawing. Again, each FAMILY will be required to purchase 6 tickets; each family need NOT purchase 6 tickets per child. Families may purchase more than three tickets if they so desire.
